Support and Growth of ZLS!

Each year, Zion does an annual fund drive, in which we send letters out to our community to raise support for our school. This fundraiser helps support teachers and provides for other expenses of our school. I am excited to announce that this year's fundraiser raised \$30,000 for our school! I cannot thank donors enough for their generosity and support to our school. The Lord Jesus continues to provide for us and uses many to accomplish his purposes. Praise the Lord!

Earlier this week the Zion Lutheran School Board approved to start a Bridge program that will begin next school year. This Bridge program will be a hybrid of homeschooling and day schooling. Bridge students will be homeschooled on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays and will be on campus on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Our 5-day model will continue as normal and the bridge students will be integrated into the current schedule and curriculum of ZLS. I'm excited for this program because it will grow our school as we partner with homeschool families in the area.

Weekly Church Attendance: Zion Lutheran School has historically taken Church attendance of students as one way of measuring the religious culture of our school. ZLS will be reintroducing church attendance this year starting in February. Each Monday teachers will ask each student if he/she went to Church on Sunday. 
