This year our focus of spiritual education is based on the Church calendar. The chapel readings, the colors of the altar paraments, the sermon texts, and hymns are chosen to fit the season of the Church calendar. Familiar seasons include Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter. But right now we are in the Trinity season, or the long green season. At the end of this season the focus is on end times, judgment, and the eternal resurrection!

This week in Matins, I preached to the students that true Christian happiness is found in being with Jesus Christ forever. We have to wait for this ultimate happiness and often we suffer in this life, but the faithful look eagerly to the final coming of our Lord. On judgment day, repentant sinners who believe in Jesus Christ as the only true God will be made like Christ and will join Him in living forever. Thanks be to the Lord Jesus for saving us sinners, who deserve judgment, but will escape the Judgement by His grace through faith in Him.

• 6th, 7th - 6 cans of Green Beans per family



Kris has served in several positions within the church. She was a member on the Ministry Council for two terms, served on the Altar Guild and most recently served on the Pastoral Call Committee. She also served on the School Board for three terms as a member, secretary, and chairman. During her tenure with the School Board they painted the school inside and out, replaced some flooring, and other various projects. She also substituted one year as the Kindergarten Teacher.
