Zion Lutheran Families,

This year, students are learning about the 7 Virtues and this month the virtue is "Hope." Christian hope is different then how we typically use the word hope. If you are running late and "hope " you will make it to school on time, you *want* to get there on time, but unless the traffic's just right, you will be tardy! Christian hope is quite different. It's not a wish, it's an expectation. We expect and look forward to eternal life; we know he will resurrect us on the last day because our hope is founded on His own resurrection!

Christian hope is not an absent-mindedness from this world. C.S. Lewis in Mere Christianity explains that those who impact this life the most are the very same people preoccupied with the next life. "Aim at Heaven and you will get earth 'thrown in'; aim at earth and you will get neither." Aiming at eternal life is not an optional part of the Christian life, it is the entire goal. It is not merely a good thing to do, it is what we are designed to do. And we truly have hope when our greatest desire is eternal life. St. Paul modeled this when he wrote,

...Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain. But if I live on in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my labor; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell. For I am hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better...

The Apostle Paul actually wanted to die because he knew that eternal rest and happiness awaited Him in his death. May our Lord Jesus Christ, our true hope, continue to increase our desire and expectation for the eternal resurrection. Amen.
