The Best Christmas Pageant Ever



Volunteer History Teacher Mrs. Anne Lee Schumacher

We would like to say a heartfelt thank-you to **Mrs. Anne Lee Schumacher** our Medieval History Teacher for 5th - 7th grades!

This wonderful history teacher started volunteering with Zion Lutheran School at the beginning of School Year 2024-25. Mrs. Schumacher has 30 years of experience in education with 10 years in Lutheran education. She teaches three times a week on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Mrs. Schumacher's undergraduate degree is in International Business. After receiving her Bachelor of Arts degree, she immediately pursued graduate studies in education. She started her teaching career in Mountain View, CA and has taught both in the public and parochial school systems. While in California, she met her future husband James who she followed to Wisconsin and was later married to in 1996.

She began her parochial teaching career at Peace Lutheran School where she taught for over 10 years. She also pursued and received a Masters Degree in German and Literature. Her studies in German took her twice to Germany during a summer in Marburg, Germany and later in Giessen, Germany. While at Peace Lutheran School she was also asked to develop and teach Latin which was extremely rewarding to her. She developed a highly successful Latin program for 3rd through 8th grade.

Anne Lee and James moved to Idaho's Treasure Valley in October of 2022 to find a drier desert climate that would be better suited for health reasons. She and James became members of Good Shepherd Evangelical Lutheran Church in Boise. She volunteers as a member of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML), and the Fellowship Board.

She and her husband James now live in Middleton where they like to travel and take the roads less traveled and spend time in the mountains. They love to garden, cook, do canning and entertain in their home while sharing a good bottle of wine. James is also a bike rider.
